

Catching up on Missing Vaccines: Children Attending Child Care

Children may be missing vaccines due to challenges accessing primary care providers during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Unsure if Doses are Missing

- Check your child's ICON (Immunization Connect ONtario) account for a list of vaccines they have received, other than the COVID-19 vaccine; visit [TBDHU.com/immunizations](https://tbdhu.com/immunizations).
 - No ICON account or have questions? Contact TBDHU at 625-5900 OR email vaccines@tbdhu.com (provide first name/phone number).
- Contact your child's primary care provider to ask about their vaccine record.

Update their Record

- Ask your health care provider if they have notified TBDHU of any vaccines, other than COVID-19 vaccines, that your child received at their office.
- TBDHU will not automatically receive the record of immunization.
 - Primary care providers must send it to TBDHU; **OR**
 - P4arents/guardians must get a copy of the record and provide it to TBDHU by uploading to ICON **OR** by providing a paper copy. Visit [TBDHU.com/vaxreport](https://tbdhu.com/vaxreport) for details.

- Contact your primary care provider to make an appointment.
